



Measuring the impact of Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) spending 2016 -17

Early Years Foundation Stage

32% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 12 pupils (9 boys and 3 girls).
58% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the GLD. Nationally, 72% of non - disadvantaged pupils achieved the GLD. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 14%. National Disadvantaged is 54%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Phonics screening Test

40% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 12 pupils (7 boys and 5 girls).
75% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the standard compared to 83% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 8%. National Disadvantaged is 69%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Keys stage 1

Reading School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

35% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 7 pupils (2 boys and 5 girls).
71% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 77% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 6%. National Disadvantaged is 60%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Writing School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

35% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 7 pupils (2 boys and 5 girls).
57% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 68% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 11%. National Disadvantaged is 50%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Maths School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

35% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 7 pupils (2 boys and 5 girls).
71% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 75% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 4%. National Disadvantaged is 58%. The performance of Disadvantaged pupils in school is similar or better than 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Key Stage 2

RWM combined (EXP) School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

49% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 17 pupils (6 boys and 11 girls).
41% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 60% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 19%. National

Disadvantaged is 39%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Reading School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

49% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 17 pupils (6 boys and 11 girls).

53% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 72% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 19%. National Disadvantaged is 53%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Writing School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

49% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 17 pupils (6 boys and 11 girls).

59% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 79% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 20%. National Disadvantaged is 54%. Disadvantaged pupils are below Disadvantaged pupils Nationally.

Maths School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

49% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 17 pupils (6 boys and 11 girls).

71% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 76% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 5%. National Disadvantaged is 58%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar School Disadvantaged vs National 'Other' (Not Disadvantaged)

49% of pupils are Disadvantaged - 17 pupils (6 boys and 11 girls).

59% of Disadvantaged pupils achieved the expected standard compared to 78% of 'Other' pupils Nationally. Therefore, there is an achievement gap of 19%. National Disadvantaged is 61%. Disadvantaged pupils performance is similar or better than Disadvantaged pupils Nationally, but still below 'Other' pupils Nationally.
