Please note that you can pay for weeks in advance.




HALF TERM

The next part of the morning was what the children would definitely term as the highlight of the day as they made their way around the ground on a full stadium tour. They visited the concourse, the home and away dressing rooms, the pitch and also the press room where children were chosen to hold a press conference of their own. The morning ended with the Show Racism the Red Card master class where the children were introduced to the intricate detail of this sensitive and vastly important area. After lunch, ex-footballers, present Boro players and members of the press attended a Q and A session where the children threw questions at the panel made up of the players. However, the final flourish of the day was our children being represented in the evening news on the BBC and in the local edition of Coastal View.
