Just to clarify from NHS England:

'A normal temperature in babies and children is about 36.4C, but this can vary slightly. A high temperature or fever is usually considered to be a temperature of 38C or above'

You cannot see Covid 19 and if a child has **any one of the three symptoms** the guidance for schools is clear that the child must return home, and if symptoms of Covid develop, you should get a Covid test for them.
