Phonics

In phonics today, I would like you to watch the video link below. This is a recap of Phase 2. Next week, we are going to be starting Phase 3 phonics and learning lots of new phonemes. I am very excited to start the next phase and we will be able to watch Geraldine the Giraffe too.

If you are unable to access the video, I would like you to recap all your phase 2 sounds. You could make a set of phase 2 flashcards.

Then I would like you to collect some objects from around your house and think of which sound they begin with. You could write this sound down on some paper.

For an extra challenge, I would like you to write some words which have 3 sounds - can you think of some? I thought of cat, hat, pat, bell, huff and hiss. Remember hiss has three sounds which are h-i-ss - you could count the sounds on your fingers to check.

Activities

Here are some activities you have a go at:

- Collect some boxes and things from around your house to make a model. You could use some old food boxes, some washing up bottles, some milk bottle tops or anything that might go in the recycling bin. Now, you can make your own model. I am going to try and make a little house for my puppy.
- Go on a shape hunt. See if you can find a square, a triangle, a circle and a rectangle in your house. Talk to your family about how you know what each shape looks like.

I have been reading again today, remember to try and read a book every day as this is very important. Today, I read Funny Bones. Can you remember who the author is? Well done for all the people who guessed correctly... yes! It is Julia Donaldson.

I have also added the link here to Phonics Play. This website is fantastic for phonics games and I know you all enjoy playing them in school. The website is now free during lockdown using the username: jan21 and password: home.
